BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE # 2018-1779

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING USES PERMITTED IN THE I INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT AND AMENDING CHAPTER XII OF THE BOROUGH LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE ENTITLED "ZONING"

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To repeal Ordinance #15-1699 which added a materials recovery facility as a principal permitted use in the I Industrial District

WHEREAS, Ordinance #15-1699, adopted August 10, 2015, amended the Borough

Land Use Ordinance to include a materials recovery facility as a principal permitted use in the I

Industrial District; and

WHEREAS, lots 2 and 2.23-2.49 in block 100 and lots 1 and 2 in block 145 (hereinafter

referred to as the "Quarry Site") comprise the I Industrial District; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of Ordinance #15-1699, the Borough entered

into an agreement with the Fair Share Housing Center ("FSHC") to settle the Borough's Mt.

Laurel Declaratory Judgment action; and

WHEREAS, that settlement, as memorialized in a November 22, 2017 letter agreement,

provided in relevant part that "The Borough will provide overlay zoning to lots 2 and 2.23-2.49

in block 100 and lots 1 and 2 in block 145 (the "Quarry Site Overlay") permitting 340 total units,

including 51, or 15%, affordable family rental units ... "; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the settlement agreement with FSHC, the Borough Planning Board adopted a Housing Element and Fair Share Plan ("HEFSP") on May 24, 2018, which states that:

"The total area of the quarry site is 72.87 acres of which 28.66 acres are developable . . . The Borough will provide overlay zoning permitting 340 total units, including 51, or 15% affordable family rental units . . . "; and

WHEREAS, the HEFSP and the terms of the settlement agreement with FSHC were

implemented by the Borough Council on June 11, 2018 when it adopted Ordinance #18-1772

entitled "An Ordinance Adopting Zoning Regulations Necessary to Implement the Borough's

Mt. Laurel Settlement Agreement with Fair Share Housing Center . . . "; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance #18-1772 provides in Section 3 that:

Paragraph 'a' entitled 'Zoning Map Amendments' in subsection 12-2.2 entitled Zoning Map' is hereby supplemented and amended by adding the following new paragraphs which read as follows:

"3. The Zoning Map is amended to change the designation of Block 100, Lots 2 and 2.23-2.49 and Block 145, Lots 1 and 2, Quarry Site to AHO-4 Affordable Housing Overlay 4 in addition to its zoning designation of I Industrial District.

WHEREAS, Ordinance #18-1772 goes on to create a new "AHO-4 Affordable Housing

District" on the Quarry Site, the primary intended use of which is "Affordable multi-family

dwellings"; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the HEFSP by the Planning Board on May 29, 2018

rendered Ordinance #15-1699 inconsistent with the Master Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of

Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that Chapter XII of the Borough

Land Use Code Entitled "Zoning" is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 1-3.2 entitled "Definitions" is amended by deleting the definitions of

"Materials Recovery Facility", "Construction and Demolition Solid Waste" and "Bulky Solid Waste".

Section 2. Section 12-18.1 entitled "Primary Intended Use [in the I Industrial District]" is amended by deleting subparagraph "j" entitled "Materials Recovery Facility" in its entirety.

Section 3. Section 12-18.1 is further amended by deleting subparagraph "k" in its entirety.

Section 4. Section 12-18.1 is further amended by revising subparagraph "h" to read as follows:

"h. Recycling facility for the recycling of concrete, trees, tree parts, asphalt and soil."

Section 5. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 6. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

1-3.2 Definitions.

Bulky Solid Waste shall mean large items of waste material, such as appliances and furniture. (Ord. No. 2015-1699 § 1)

Construction and Demolition Solid Waste shall mean building material and rubble resulting from construction, remodeling, repair and demolition operations on houses, commercial buildings, pavements and other structures. (Ord. No. 2015-1699 §-1)

Materials Recovery Facility shall mean a small scale recovery solid waste facility which is primarily designed, operated and permitted to process a nonhazardous solid waste stream by utilizing manual and/or mechanical methods to separate from the incoming waste stream categories of useful materials which are then returned to the economic mainstream in the form of raw materials or product of reuse. (Ord. No. 2015-1699 § 1)

12-18 I INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

12-18.1 Primary Intended Use.

In the Industrial District a building may be erected or used and a lot may be used or occupied for any of the following purposes and uses and no other: a. The processing of stone, trees, tree parts, or rock products. Processing shall include grinding, polishing, coloring and otherwise treating the raw materials, as well as, the further use of such products in the manufacture of derivative or secondary products which are substantially different in form or character from the original raw materials.

b. Bulk storage, wholesale and warehousing. (1) Wholesale establishments including, but not limited to, lumber and building materials sales, machinery sales and service, contractors' heavy equipment sales, rental and service and nursery and landscaping sales; (2) the storage of building material, trees, tree parts and bulk materials; (3) the parking or storage of vehicles or the maintenance or repair of commercial and industrial vehicles or equipment; and (4) parcel delivery and service distribution facilities.

c. Shops such as construction and industrial trade shops, boat works (custom building and repair), ornamental iron workshops and monument works.

- d. The manufacture or assembly of small parts and equipment.
- e. Public utilities and facilities.
- f. Self-storage facilities.

g. Fuel oil storage and distribution.

h. Recycling facility for the recycling of concrete, trees, tree parts, asphalt and soil.

I. Retail sales shall be allowed as an accessory use incidental and subordinate to uses permitted in this zone. Areas devoted to retail sales shall be limited to one thousand (1,000) square feet.

_____j.___Materials recovery facility shall be subject to the following:

------1. Materials to be recovered and recycled are limited to construction, demolition, and bulky solid waste, and

Demonstration that the applicant-user can comply with all
 Somerset County and State Department of Environmental Protection rules
 and regulations, including, but not limited to, N.J.A.C. 7:26-2.1 et seq; and
 Capacity of facility is less than one hundred (100) tons per day;
 and

-----4. All construction, demolition and bulky solid waste materials shall be delivered, separated and processed within an enclosed building.

(Ord. No. 2015-1699 § 2)

k. Other accessory uses on the same lot and customarily incidental to the principal use, such as office and shipping facilities, machine shop, locker room, boiler room, scale house, concrete plant, asphalt plant and rock crushers. (Ord. No. 2015-1699 § 2)

BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2018-1777

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL RULES FOR BOROUGH ADVISORY COMMITTEES AND SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING CHAPTER II OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION"

WHEREAS, the governing body has determined that it should establish procedural rules

for all Borough advisory committees;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of

Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that Chapter II of the Borough

Code Entitled "Administration" is hereby supplemented and amended as follows:

Section 1. Article V entitled "Board, Committees and Commission" is hereby

supplemented and amended by adding a new section 2-46 entitled "Uniform Advisory

Committee Procedural Rules," which reads as follows:

"2-46 Uniform Advisory Committee Procedural Rules.

2-46.1 Applicability; Scope.

Subject to any superceding State law, this section shall govern the procedural aspects pertaining to the conduct of hearings by advisory committees created by the governing body. In the event of conflict between this section and the individual sections of the Borough Code that created the various advisory committees, this chapter shall prevail. This section shall not apply to statutory boards or commissions.

2-46.2 Definitions.

The following words and terms when used in this section shall have the following meanings unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

Advisory Committee means any committee created by local ordinance which is not specifically authorized by State statute. The term 'Advisory Committee' shall include, but not be limited to, the Shade Tree Committee, the Recreation Advisory Committee, the Historic Preservation Advisory Committee, the Housing Property Maintenance and Zoning Compliance Advisory Committee and any other similar advisory committees created by ordinance, resolution or motion of the governing body.

Statutory Board or Commission means any Borough board or commission created either by State law or by local ordinance pursuant to State law. Statutory Boards or Commissions shall include, but not be limited to, the Planning Board, the Zoning Board of Adjustment, the Board of Health, the Environmental Commission, the Library Board of Trustees, the Shade Tree Commission and the Office of Emergency Management.

2-46.3 Organization of Advisory Committees.

At its annual reorganization meeting, the Borough Council shall appoint a chair and vice-chair for each advisory committee covered by this section. Chairs and vice-chairs shall serve until the next annual Council reorganization meeting. In the case of a vacancy, the Council may appoint a chair or vice-chair to fill the unexpired term. The Chair, or in his or her absence or disability, the vice-chair shall preside at all meetings of the advisory committee.

2-46.4 Annual Training.

The Borough shall provide mandatory, annual training for the chairs and vicechairs of all advisory committees so that they are familiar with parliamentary procedures and the scope of authority of their advisory committees. <u>Chairs and vice-chairs of all advisory committees shall be required to complete this</u> <u>mandatory training upon appointment as chair or vice-chair and every three years</u> <u>thereafter</u>. Each training session shall be videotaped and shown to all members of the various committees.

2-46.5 Miscellaneous Rules and Regulations.

- a. All advisory committee hearings shall be audiotaped or videotaped.
- b. Except when specifically authorized by the Open Public Meetings Act (N.J.S.A. 10:4-12), all advisory committee meetings shall be conducted in public. Members of the public, however, shall only be permitted to speak when the floor is open to them by the person chairing the meeting.
- c. The advisory committee shall act only within the scope of its duties as outlined in the applicable ordinance, resolution or motion creating the advisory committee.
- d. No individual member shall take any action on behalf of an advisory committee

- e. Advisory committees may not enter into contracts or expend any Borough funds.
- f. Borough employees shall not be permitted to attend advisory committee meetings, except in rare circumstances when the Council approves their attendance in advance.
- g. Neither advisory committees nor any or their individual members shall communicate directly with any Borough employees or officials. All such communications shall be directed through the Borough Administrator, except that the Borough Administrator may authorize the chair or vice-chair of an advisory committee to communicate directly with a Borough employee or official with a specific question or on a particular project."

Section 2. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 3. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

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BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE #18-1778

AN ORDINANCE ADDING TEN UNITS TO THE BOROUGH'S SENIOR CITIZEN AFFORDABLE HOUSING SITE ON NORTH FINLEY AVENUE AND AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE BOROUGH LAND USE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Borough entered into a November 22, 2017 agreement (the "Agreement") with Fair Share Housing Center to settle its Mt. Laurel obligations; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provided that the Borough would meet its affordable housing obligation utilizing a number of different mechanisms including 17 units through the extension of affordability controls; and

WHEREAS, 11 of those 17 units were ineligible during this round of Mount Laurel because the deeds for those units were recorded shortly after the July 1, 1995 deadline; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Board has recommended making up that 11-unit shortfall by adding 10 additional units for a total of 30 units at the North Finley Avenue (100% affordable senior rental) – Block 125, Lot 25 site – and adding one additional unit to the Market to Affordable Program thereby increasing the number of units from three to four; and

WHEREAS, the governing body agrees with the recommendations of the Planning Board;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Zoning Map of the Borough of Bernardsville is amended to change the zoning designation of Block 125, Lot 25 fronting on North Finley Avenue to AH-2 Affordable Housing District from R-3 Residence District.

Section 2. Subsections 12-20,4 through 12-20.6 in Section 12-20 of the Borough Land Ordinance entitled "AH-2 AFFORDABLE HOUSING 2 DISTRICT" are amended to read as follows:

12-20 AH-2 AFFORDABLE HOUSING 2 DISTRICT

12-20.4 Primary Intended Use

- a. Affordable family rental multi-family dwellings:
 - 1. Townhouses
 - 2. Apartments
- b. Parking and facilities in accordance with Section 9-10 of this chapter or Residential

- c. Site Improvement Standards as deemed appropriate by the local approving Board,
- d. Other accessory uses customarily incident to the above uses provide they not include any activity commonly conducted for gain unless specifically permitted by this Article.

12-20.5 Required Conditions

The following requirements must be complied with in the AH-2 Affordable Housing Districts:

- a. *Height*. No building shall exceed a maximum of three (3.0) stories or thirty-five (35) feet in height, whichever is the lesser,
- b. Front Yard. There shall be a front yard of not less than twenty-five (25) feet,
- c. *Side Yards.* There shall be two (2) side yards, and no side yard shall be less than twenty (20) feet,
- d. *Rear Yards*. There shall be a rear yard of at least twenty (20) feet,
- e. *Building Envelope*. The building envelope shall exclude areas located within flood plains, wetlands and wetland buffers, except as may be approved by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) and no floodplain nor wetlands nor wetland buffers shall be disturbed without the appropriate permits having been issued by the NJDEP.
- f. *Minimum Floor Area*. Every dwelling hereafter erected shall have a minimum floor area excluding garages of:

0 Bedroom (Studio)	500		
1 Bedroom	675		
2 Bedrooms	900		
3 Bedrooms	1000		

Units with more than 3 bedrooms are not permitted

- g. The maximum number of dwellings shall not exceed 30 rental age-restricted affordable dwellings.
- h. At least one-third of the affordable dwelling units shall be for very low-income households as defined in the definitions.
- i. Minimum distance between buildings is twenty (20) feet.

12-20.6 Design Standards

- a. The design standards contained herein shall supplement the design and performance standards contained in Article 9-10 of Borough of Bernardsville Regulations. If there is a conflict, Article 9-10, as amended from time to time, shall apply
- b. New buildings shall relate to existing buildings and other structures in the vicinity that have a visual relationship to the site.
- c. Multiple buildings on a single tract shall be designed so as to be architecturally compatible with one another, utilizing common color schemes and materials.
- d. Building facades shall be consistent with the size, scale and setbacks of adjacent buildings and those where there is a visual relationship.
- e. The appearance of the side and rear elevations of buildings is important. Therefore, guidelines for the fronts of buildings shall also apply to the rear and sides where visible at street level from a public right-of-way.
- f. Buildings shall be designed so as to prevent exterior elevations from containing large expanses of blank or featureless walls. Also, large expanses of windows, including curtain-wall windows and other design elements not at a human scale, are strongly discouraged.
- g. The type, shape, pitch, feature and color of a roof shall be architecturally compatible with the building style, material, colors and details.
- h. Flat roofs shall be enclosed by parapets or other appropriate architectural details.
- All open space shall be designed and landscaped in a way to allow for easy maintenance and limited encroachment onto any public right of way.
 Additionally, all private open space shall be designed in a way that allows for a reasonable level of enjoyment by residents.
- j. Green building strategies are encouraged in the AH-2 Zone

Section 3. Any and all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 4. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder of any portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

This term may include any of the following types of ancillary improvements to eligible Borough properties: roadways, parking, landscaping, fencing, lighting, utilities, structures, and any other improvement that expands or enhances the use of property for outdoor recreation . . . purposes.";

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of

Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Fifteen thousand (\$15,000) dollars is hereby appropriated from the

Borough Open Space Trust Fund (development) to complete a survey and a wetlands delineation

for Morraine Crest.

Section 2. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with

any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or

inconsistent.

Section 3. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 14-146.11 provides in relevant part that:

"No person may commence his duties as a special law enforcement officer unless he has successfully completed a training course approved by the commission and no special law enforcement officer may be issued a firearm unless he has completed the basic firearms course approved by the commission for permanent regularly appointed police...; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 14-146.11 further provides that:

"Class II [Special] Officers shall be authorized to exercise full powers and duties similar to those of a permanent, regularly appointed full-time police officer. The use of a firearm by an officer of this class may be authorized only after the officer has been fully certified as successfully completing training as prescribed by the commission..."; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 14-146.14 provides that:

"Special law enforcement officers may be appointed for terms not to exceed one year, and the appointments may be revoked by the local unit for cause after adequate hearing, unless the appointment is for four months or less, in which event the appointment may be revoked without cause of hearing ..."; and

WHEREAS, Chief of Police Kevin Valentine has recommended that the individual named below be appointed as a Class II Special Police Officer, subject to satisfactory completion of their medical and psychological examinations and background investigations:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Borough of Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, New Jersey as follows:

- 1. In accordance with state law, Gregory Skinner is hereby appointed as Class II Special Police Officer for a one year term at \$25.00 an hour, and conditional upon receipt of a satisfactory police employment medical and psychiatric examinations.
- 2. This Special Police Officer shall perform their duties only upon the direction of Chief of Police Kevin Valentine, or his designee.

RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDED FSHC SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, ENDORSING AMENDED HOUSING ELEMENT AND FAIR SHARE PLAN AND ADOPTING AMENDED SPENDING PLAN

WHEREAS, the Borough entered into a November 22, 2017 agreement (the "Agreement") with Fair Share Housing Center to settle its Mt. Laurel obligations; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provided that the Borough would meet its affordable housing obligation utilizing a number of different mechanisms including 17 units through the extension of affordability controls; and

WHEREAS, 11 of those 17 units were ineligible during this round of Mount Laurel because the deeds for those units were recorded shortly after the July 1, 1995 deadline; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Board recommended making up that 11-unit shortfall by adding 10 additional units for a total of 30 units at the North Finley Avenue (100% affordable senior rental) - Block 125, Lot 25 site - and adding one additional unit to the Market to Affordable Program thereby increasing the number of units from three to four; and

WHEREAS, the governing body agrees with the recommendations of the Planning Board and is adopting concurrently herewith Ordinance #18-1778 adding 10 units to the Borough's senior citizen affordable housing site on North Finley Avenue and amending various sections of the Borough Land Use Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's Mount Laurel consultant CGP&H prepared an amended Housing Element and Fair Share Plan reflecting these changes, and an amended spending plan also reflecting these change; and WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Board, at a public hearing held on August 23, 2018, approved Resolution #2018-12 adopting the August 8, 2018 amended Housing Element and Fair Share Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The governing body hereby authorizes execution of an amended settlement agreement with Fair Share Housing Center which revises the "Developments/Compliance Mechanisms" in paragraph 6 of the settlement agreement as follows:

a. Item No. 7 "North Finley Avenue (100% affordable senior rental) - block 125, lot 25 containing 1.0 acres (43,560 square feet)" is amended by increasing the number of units from 20 to 30.

b. Item No. 12 "Extension of Controls" is amended by decreasing the number of units from 17 to 6 and amending the "Details/Status" column to read as follows: "The following blocks and lots will have their deed restrictions extended: block 114, lots 1.101, 1.105, 1.106, 1.107, 1.108 and 1.124. Each of these units will have a 95/5 deed restriction that expires prior to July 1, 2025. All units will be extended for a minimum of 30 additional years"

c. Item No. 13 "Market to Affordable Program" is amended by increasing the number of units from three to four."

In all other respects, the November 22, 2017 settlement agreement between the Borough of Bernardsville and Fair Share Housing Center shall remain unchanged.

2. The governing body hereby endorses the amended Housing Element and Fair Share Plan adopted by the Planning Board on August 23, 2018. 3. The governing body hereby adopts the amended Spending Plan prepared by CGP&H and dated August 8, 2018.

4. The Borough Attorney is hereby authorized to file these amended documents with the Court and to serve copies upon Special Master Peter Buchsbaum and Kevin Walsh at the Fair Share Housing Center.

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RESOLUTION #18-204 APPOINTING CLASS III SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER

WHEREAS, the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.8 et seq. (the "Act") provides in relevant part that:

"a. Any local unit may, as it deems necessary, appoint special law enforcement officers sufficient to perform the duties and responsibilities permitted by local ordinances authorized by N.J.S. 40A: 14-118 and within the conditions and limitations as may be established pursuant to this Act" (N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.10); and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.10 goes on to provide that:

"Before any special law enforcement officer is appointed pursuant to this Act, the chief of police . . . shall ascertain the eligibility and qualifications of the applicant and report these determinations in writing to the appointing authority ..."; and

WHEREAS, the Act was amended, effective June 1, 2017, to create a new Class III of special police officers, as follows:

"Class Three. Officers of this class shall be authorized to exercise full powers and duties similar to those of a permanent, regularly appointed full-time police officer while providing security at a public or nonpublic school or a county college on the school or college premises during hours when the public or nonpublic school or county college is normally in session or when it is occupied by public or nonpublic school or county college students or their teachers or professors. While on duty in the jurisdiction of employment, an officer may respond to offenses or emergencies off school or college grounds if they occur in the officer's presence while traveling to a school facility or county college, but an officer shall not otherwise be dispatched or dedicated to any assignment off school or college property. The use of a firearm by an officer of this class shall be authorized pursuant to the provisions of subsection b. of section 7 of P.L.1985, c.439 (C.40A:14-146.14).

An officer of this class shall not be authorized to carry a firearm while off duty unless the officer complies with the requirements set forth in subsection l. of N.J.S.2C:39-6 authorizing a retired law enforcement officer to carry a handgun." (*N.J. Stat. § 40A:14-146.11*); and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.10, as amended also provides that:

g. In addition to the qualifications established in subsection b. of this section, a person shall not be appointed as a Class Three special law enforcement officer unless the person:

(1) is a retired law enforcement officer who is less than 65 years of age; for the purposes of this paragraph, a law enforcement officer shall not be considered retired if the officer's return to employment violates any federal or State law or regulation which would deem the officer's retirement as not being bona fide;

(2) had served as a duly qualified, fully-trained, full-time officer in any municipality or county of this State or as a member of the State Police and was separated from that prior service in good standing, within three years of appointment, except during the first year following the effective date [June 1, 2017] of P.L.2016, c.68, was separated from that prior service within five years of appointment;

(3) is physically capable of performing the functions of the position, determined in accordance with Police Training Commission guidelines;

(4) possesses a New Jersey Police Training Commission Basic Police Officer Certification or New Jersey State Police Academy Certification;

(5) has completed the training course for safe schools resource officers developed pursuant to subsection a. of section 2 of P.L.2005, c.276 (C.52:17B-71.8); and

(6) is hired in a part-time capacity.

WHEREAS, Chief of Police Kevin Valentine and Superintendent of the Somerset Hills Regional School District Gretchen Dempsey have negotiated a one-year agreement whereby the Police Department will place two Class III Special Police Officers in the schools for the 2018-2019 school year and, in return, the School District will reimburse the Borough \$115,000 to cover the cost of those Class III Special Police Officers;

WHEREAS, Michael Kilhberg, retired at the rank of Sheriff's Officer by the Essex County Sheriff's Office, meets the qualifications set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.10; and

WHEREAS, Chief of Police Kevin Valentine has recommended that Michael Kilhberg be appointed as a Class III Special Police Officer, subject to satisfactory completion of his medical and psychological examinations and background investigations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Borough of Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, New Jersey as follows:

1. In accordance with state law, Michael Kilhberg is hereby appointed as Class III Special Police Officer for a one-year term, at \$27.50 an hour, and conditioned

upon receipt of a satisfactory background investigation and police employment medical and psychological examinations. The appointment is also conditioned on the Bernardsville Police Department obtaining a waiver from Basic Police Officer to SLEO III upon Officer Kilhberg's appointment in accordance with New Jersey Police Training Commission (NJPTC) guidelines.

2. Special Police Officer Kilhberg shall perform his duties only upon the direction of Chief of Police Kevin Valentine, or his designee.
