CONCERNING SPECIAL EVENTS AND AMENDING CHAPTER 4 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "GENERAL LICENSING"

WHEREAS, the current special events ordinance has not been updated to reflect the types of

events that are held in the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville in

the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that Chapter 4 of the Borough Code Entitled "General

Licensing" is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 4-12.1 entitled "Definitions" and subsection 4-12.6 entitled "Fees" in §4-

12 entitled "Special Event Licenses" are amended to read as follows:

"4-12.1. Definitions

SPECIAL EVENT - Special events are categorized as follows:

- <u>Category A</u> Shall mean any show, circus, fair or similar event, or a series of such <u>event held on</u> <u>municipal property</u>, at which goods or services are offered to the public for a consideration as admission, other than sales by a merchant in the ordinary course of business at its premises.
- <u>Category B</u>- <u>Shall mean one-day events including cultural, historical, and seasonal celebrations</u> that are on municipal property or public roads, that are open to the public, and that are sponsored by the Borough or quasi municipal entities such as the Bernardsville Fire Company and Downtown Bernardsville and the purpose of which is to promote economic development; educational initiatives; or the general health safety and welfare of the community.</u>

4-12.6. Fees.

The sponsor and the concessionaire shall be liable for the following fees: which are based on the number of days ahead of the proposed special event that complete applications are filed:

<u>Category A – These fees are based on the number of days ahead of the proposed special event</u> <u>that complete applications are filed.</u>

a. Sponsor - Special Event Permit - Fee per Event.

60 days before event	\$50
30 days before event	\$100
21 days before event	\$200
14 days before event	\$500
7 days before event	\$1,000

b. Each Concessionaire - Fee per Day.

c. No fee shall be refundable for any reason.

If completed applications and all other required documentation are not filed and if all fees are not paid in full at least three business days before the proposed special event, the special event may not be held.

Category B - The fees for these events shall be as follows:

\$20 for each mobile food vendor.

"§12-23.24 Small Accessory Mechanical Equipment Setbacks in Residential Zones.

- Electrical and mechanical equipment, including generators and air conditioning units, shall be located within the interior of a building envelope wherever possible. When an interior building envelope location is not practical, such equipment shall be placed in a location where it can be substantially screened. Ground level utilities shall be screened with dense landscaping and/or fencing so as to unobtrusive when viewed from the public rights-of-way and adjacent uses.
- 2. Exterior residential mechanical equipment including heat pumps, air conditioning condensers and generators, shall be located in accordance with the following:
 - a. Within the R-1, R-1A, R-1-10, and R-2 zones, air conditioning units and generators shall have a minimum required setback of fifteen (15) feet

from side lot lines and a minimum required rear yard setback of fifteen (15) feet.

- b. Within the R-3, R-4, and R-5 Zones, air conditioning units and generators shall have a minimum required side yard setback of five (5) feet and a minimum required rear yard setback of five (5) feet.
- c. Within the R-1, R-1A, R-1-10, and R-2 zones, air conditioning units and generators (and any above ground mechanicals that service the principal structure) in the front yard shall comply with the minimum required principal building front yard setback. Any equipment located in the front or side yard must be screened with dense landscaping and /or fencing.
- d. Within the R-3, R-4, R-5 zones, air conditioning units and generators (and any above ground mechanicals that service the principal structure) in the front yard shall be no further than five (5) feet from the principal structure's footprint. Any equipment located in the front or side yard must be screened with dense landscaping and /or fencing.
- e. Air conditioning units and generators serving detached accessory buildings/structures shall have minimum required side and rear yard setback of the zone bulk requirements in which the lot is located.
- f. Small Accessory Mechanical Equipment in any zoning district that is not mentioned in the preceding paragraphs shall require site plan review. The Downtown, I, and I-2 zoning districts have their own regulations as set forth in chapter 12-12."

- 2. Exterior residential mechanical equipment, including heat pumps, air conditioning condensers and generators, <u>outside of the building envelope</u> shall be located in accordance with the following:
 - a. Within the R-1, R-1A, R-1-10, and R-2 zones, air conditioning units and generators shall have a minimum required setback of fifteen (15) feet from side lot lines and a minimum required rear yard setback of fifteen (15) feet.
 - b. Within the R-3, R-4, R-5, <u>R-10A and R-10B</u> zones, air conditioning units and generators shall have a minimum required side yard setback of five (5) feet and a minimum required rear yard setback of five (5) feet.

- c. Within the R-1, R-1A, R-1-10, and R-2 zones, air conditioning units and generators (and any above ground mechanicals that service the principal structure) in the front yard shall comply with the minimum required principal building front yard setback. Any equipment located in the front or side yard must be screened with dense landscaping and /or fencing.
- d. Within the R-3, R-4, R-5 <u>R-10A and R-10B</u> zones, air conditioning units and generators (and any above ground mechanicals that service the principal structure) in the front yard shall be no further than five (5) feet from the principal structure's footprint. Any equipment located in the front or side yard must be screened with dense landscaping and /or fencing.
- e. Air conditioning units and generators serving detached accessory buildings/structures shall have minimum required side and rear yard setback of the zone bulk requirements in which the lot is located.
- f. Small Accessory Mechanical Equipment in any zoning district that is not mentioned in the preceding paragraphs shall require site plan review. The Downtown, I, and I-2 zoning districts have their own regulations as set forth in chapter 12-12."

Section2. Paragraph "e" of subsection 12-12.13 entitled "Placement of Buildings" in

Section 12-12 entitled "Downtown District" is amended to read as follows:

e. Minor elements such as accessory utility structures, mechanical equipment, fences, walls, driveways, walkways, and uncovered stoops and porches may encroach into all setbacks but not across property lines. <u>Mechanical equipment must comply with the requirements of Section 12-23.24 below.</u>

AUTHORIZING AND ENCOURAGING ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY/SERVICE EQUIPMENT (EVSE) & MAKE-READY PARKING SPACES AND SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING ARTICLE 12 OF THE BOROUGH LAND USE REGULATIONS ENTITLED "ZONING"

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This Ordinance sets forth procedures for the installation of Electric Vehicle Supply/Service Equipment (EVSE) and Make-Ready parking spaces and establishes associated regulations and other standards within the Borough.

WHEREAS, supporting the transition to electric vehicles contributes to Borough of Bernardsville's commitment to sustainability and is in the best interest of public welfare; and

WHEREAS, installation of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces encourages electric vehicle adoption; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bernardsville encourages increased installation of EVSE and Make Ready parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this ordinance supports the State of New Jersey's goals to reduce air pollutants and greenhouse gas emissions from the transportation sector as outlined and supported by various programs related to NJ's 2019 Energy Master Plan, Global Warming Response Act (P.L.2007, c.112 (C.26:2C-37 et al.)), and EV Law (P.L. 2019, c. 362); and

WHEREAS, P.L. 2021, c.171, which Governor Murphy signed into law on July 9, 2021, requires EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces be designated as a permitted accessory use in all zoning or use districts and establishes associated installation and parking requirements; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this ordinance will support the Master Plan of Borough of Bernardsville adopted in concurrence with P.L. 1975 c. 291, s. 1 eff. Aug. 1, 1976, and is consistent with goals of the Master Plan as well as the land use and circulation elements of the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bernardsville encourages greater ownership and use of electric vehicles, thus the Borough of Bernardsville is amending the Borough Land development Regulations to establish standards and regulations for the safe and efficient installation of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces at appropriate locations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the *Council* of the **Borough of Bernardsville**, County of **Somerset**, State of New Jersey that Article 12 of the Borough Land Use regulations entitled "Zoning" is hereby supplemented and amended as follows::

Section 1. Section 12-23 entitled "Supplementary regulations" is supplemented and amended by adding a new subsection 12-23.24 entitled "Electric Vehicle Supply/Service Equipment" which reads as follows:

12-23.4. ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY/SERVICE EQUIPMENT

A. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to promote and encourage the use of electric vehicles by requiring the safe and efficient installation of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces through municipal parking regulations and other standards. EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces will support the State's transition to an electric transportation sector, reducing automobile air pollution, greenhouse gas emissions, and storm water runoff contaminants. The goals are to:

- 1. Provide adequate and convenient EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces to serve the needs of the traveling public.
- 2. Provide opportunities for residents to have safe and efficient personal EVSE located at or near their place of residence.
- 3. Provide the opportunity for non-residential uses to supply EVSE to their customers and employees.
- 4. Create standard criteria to encourage and promote safe, efficient, and costeffective electric vehicle charging opportunities in all zones and settings for convenience of service to those that use electric vehicles.

B. Definitions

<u>Certificate of occupancy</u>: The certificate provided for in N.J.A.C. 5:23-2, indicating that the construction authorized by the construction permit has been completed in accordance with the construction permit, the act and the regulations. See "State Uniform Construction Code Act," P.L.1975, c.217 (C.52:27D-119 et seq.) and regulations adopted pursuant thereto.

<u>Charging Level</u>: The amount of voltage provided to charge an electric vehicle varies depending on the type of EVSE as follows:

- 1. Level 1 operates on a fifteen (15) to twenty (20) amp breaker on a one hundred twenty (120) volt AC circuit.
- 2. Level 2 operates on a forty (40) to one hundred (100) amp breaker on a two hundred eight (208) or two hundred forty (240) volt AC circuit.

3. Direct-current fast charger (DCFC) operates on a sixty (60) amp or higher breaker on a four hundred eighty (480) volt or higher three phase circuit with special grounding equipment. DCFC stations can also be referred to as rapid charging stations that are typically characterized by industrial grade electrical outlets that allow for faster recharging of electric vehicles.

<u>Electric vehicle</u>: Any vehicle that is licensed and registered for operation on public and private highways, roads, and streets; and operates either partially or exclusively using an electric motor powered by an externally charged on-board battery.

<u>Electric Vehicle Supply/Service Equipment or (EVSE)</u>: The equipment, including the cables, cords, conductors, connectors, couplers, enclosures, attachment plugs, power outlets, power electronics, transformer, switchgear, switches and controls, network interfaces, point of sale equipment, and associated apparatus designed and used for the purpose of transferring energy from the electric supply system to a plug-in electric vehicle. "EVSE" may deliver either alternating current or, consistent with fast charging equipment standards, direct current electricity. "EVSE" is synonymous with "electric vehicle charging station." *{Note: Definition is directly from legislation and cannot be changed.}*

<u>Make-Ready Parking Space</u>: means the pre-wiring of electrical infrastructure at a parking space, or set of parking spaces, to facilitate easy and cost-efficient future installation of Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment or Electric Vehicle Service Equipment, including, but not limited to, Level Two EVSE and direct current fast chargers. Make Ready includes expenses related to service panels, junction boxes, conduit, wiring, and other components necessary to make a particular location able to accommodate Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment or Electric Vehicle Service Equipment on a "plug and play" basis. "Make-Ready" is synonymous with the term "charger ready," as used in P.L.2019, c.362 (C.48:25-1 et al.). *[Note: Definition is directly from legislation and cannot be changed.]*

<u>Private EVSE</u>: EVSE that has restricted access to specific users (e.g., single and two-family homes, executive parking fleet parking with no access to the general public).

<u>Publicly-accessible EVSE</u>: EVSE that is publicly available (e.g., park & ride, public parking lots and garages, on-street parking, shopping center parking, non-reserved parking in multi-family parking lots, etc.).

C. Approvals and Permits

- An application for development submitted solely for the installation of EVSE or Make-Ready parking spaces shall be considered a permitted accessory use and permitted accessory structure in all zoning or use districts and shall not require a variance pursuant to C.40:55D-70.
- 2. EVSE and Make-Ready Parking Spaces installed pursuant to Section D. below in development applications that are subject to site plan approval are considered a permitted accessory use as described in 1. above.
- 3. All EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces shall be subject to applicable local and/or Department of Community Affairs permit and inspection requirements.
- 4. The Borough Zoning Officer shall enforce all signage and installation requirements described in this ordinance. Failure to meet the requirements in this ordinance shall be subject to the same enforcement and penalty provisions as other violations of Borough of Bernardsville's land use regulations.
- 5. An application for development for the installation of EVSE or Make-Ready spaces at an existing gasoline service station, an existing retail establishment, or any other existing building shall not be subject to site plan or other land use board review, shall not require variance relief pursuant to C.40:55D-1 et seq. or any other law, rule, or regulation, and shall be approved through the issuance of a zoning permit by the administrative officer, provided the application meets the following requirements:
 - a. the proposed installation does not violate bulk requirements applicable to the property or the conditions of the original final approval of the site plan or subsequent approvals for the existing gasoline service station, retail establishment, or other existing building;
 - all other conditions of prior approvals for the gasoline service station, the existing retail establishment, or any other existing building continue to be met; and
 - c. the proposed installation complies with the construction codes adopted in or promulgated pursuant to the "State Uniform Construction Code Act,"
 P.L.1975, c.217 (C.52:27D-119 et seq.), any safety standards concerning the installation, and any State rule or regulation concerning electric vehicle charging stations.

- 6. An application pursuant to Section 5. above shall be deemed complete if:
 - a. the application, including the permit fee and all necessary documentation, is determined to be complete,
 - b. a notice of incompleteness is not provided within 20 days after the filing of the application, or
 - **c.** a one-time written correction notice is not issued by the Zoning Officer within 20 days after filing of the application detailing all deficiencies in the application and identifying any additional information explicitly necessary to complete a review of the permit application.
- 7. EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces installed at a gasoline service station, an existing retail establishment, or any other existing building shall be subject to applicable local and/or Department of Community Affairs inspection requirements.
- 8. A permitting application solely for the installation of electric vehicle supply equipment permitted as an accessory use shall not be subject to review based on parking requirements.

D. Requirements for New Installation of EVSE and Make-Ready Parking Spaces

- 1. As a condition of preliminary site plan approval, for each application involving a multiple dwelling with five or more units of dwelling space, which shall include a multiple dwelling that is held under a condominium or cooperative form of ownership, a mutual housing corporation, or a mixed-use development, the developer or owner, as applicable, shall:
 - prepare as Make-Ready parking spaces at least 15 percent of the required off-street parking spaces, and install EVSE in at least one-third of the 15 percent of Make-Ready parking spaces;
 - b. within three years following the date of the issuance of the certificate of occupancy, install EVSE in an additional one-third of the original 15 percent of Make-Ready parking spaces; and
 - c. within six years following the date of the issuance of the certificate of occupancy, install EVSE in the final one-third of the original 15 percent of Make-Ready parking spaces.
 - d. Throughout the installation of EVSE in the Make-Ready parking spaces, at least five percent of the electric vehicle supply equipment shall be accessible for people with disabilities.
 - e. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to restrict the ability to install electric vehicle supply equipment or Make-Ready parking spaces at a faster or more expansive rate than as required above.

- 2. As a condition of preliminary site plan approval, each application involving a parking lot or garage not covered in 1. above shall:
 - a. Install at least one Make-Ready parking space if there will be 50 or fewer off-street parking spaces.
 - b. Install at least two Make-Ready parking spaces if there will be 51 to 75 off-street parking spaces.
 - c. Install at least three Make-Ready parking spaces if there will be 76 to 100 off-street parking spaces.
 - d. Install at least four Make-Ready parking spaces, at least one of which shall be accessible for people with disabilities, if there will be 101 to 150 off-street parking spaces.
 - e. Install at least four percent of the total parking spaces as Make-Ready parking spaces, at least five percent of which shall be accessible for people with disabilities, if there will be more than 150 off-street parking spaces.
 - f. In lieu of installing Make-Ready parking spaces, a parking lot or garage may install EVSE to satisfy the requirements of this subsection.
 - g. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to restrict the ability to install electric vehicle supply equipment or Make-Ready parking spaces at a faster or more expansive rate than as required above.
 - f. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section E above, a retailer that provides 25 or fewer off-street parking spaces or the developer or owner of a single-family home shall not be required to provide or install any electric vehicle supply equipment or Make-Ready parking spaces.

E. Minimum Parking Requirements

{Note: Section E of the model ordinance is mandatory and may not be altered. }

- 1. All parking spaces with EVSE and Make-Ready equipment shall be included in the calculation of minimum required parking spaces in that zone.
- 2. A parking space prepared with EVSE or Make-Ready equipment shall count as at least two parking spaces for the purpose of complying with a minimum parking space requirement. This shall result in a reduction of no more than 10 percent of the total required parking.
- 3. All parking space calculations for EVSE and Make-Ready equipment shall be rounded up to the next full parking space.

4. Additional installation of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces above what is required in Section D. above may be encouraged, but shall not be required in development projects.

F. Reasonable Standards for All New EVSE and Make-Ready Parking Spaces

1. Location and layout of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces is expected to vary based on the design and use of the primary parking area. It is expected flexibility will be required to provide the most convenient and functional service to users. Standards and criteria should be considered guidelines and flexibility should be allowed when alternatives can better achieve objectives for provision of this service.

2. Installation:

- a. Installation of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces shall meet the electrical subcode of the Uniform Construction Code, N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.16.
- b. Each EVSE or Make-Ready parking space that is not accessible for people with disabilities shall be not less than 9 feet wide or 18 feet in length. Exceptions may be made for existing parking spaces or parking spaces that were part of an application that received prior site plan approval.
- c. To the extent practical, the location of accessible parking spaces for people with disabilities with EVSE and Make Ready equipment shall comply with the general accessibility requirements of the Uniform Construction Code, N.J.A.C. 5:23, and other applicable accessibility standards.
- d. Each EVSE or Make-Ready parking space that is accessible for people with disabilities shall comply with the sizing of accessible parking space requirements in the Uniform Construction Code, N.J.A.C. 5:23, and other applicable accessibility standards.

3. EVSE Parking:

- a. Publicly-accessible EVSE shall be reserved for parking and charging electric vehicles only. Electric vehicles shall be connected to the EVSE. {*Note: The use of time limits is optional and shall be determined by the owner.*}
- b. Electric vehicles may be parked in any parking space designated for parking, subject to the restrictions that would apply to any other vehicle that would park in that space.
- c. Public Parking. Pursuant to NJSA 40:48-2, publicly-accessible EVSE parking spaces shall be monitored by the municipality's police department and enforced in the same manner as any other parking. It shall be a violation of this Section to park or stand a non-electric vehicle in such a space, or to park an electric vehicle in such a space when it is not connected to the EVSE. Any non-electric vehicle parked or

standing in a EVSE parking space or any electric vehicle parked and not connected to the EVSE shall be is subject to fine and/or impoundment of the offending vehicle as described in the general penalty provisions set forth in Section 1-5 of the Borough Code. Signage indicating the penalties for violations shall comply with Section 5. below. Any vehicle parked in such a space shall make the appropriate payment for the space and observe the time limit for the underlying parking area, if applicable.

- d. Private Parking. The use of EVSE shall be monitored by the property owner or designee.
- 4. Safety
 - a. Each publicly-accessible EVSE shall be located at a parking space that is designated for electric vehicles only and identified by green painted pavement and/or curb markings, a green painted charging pictograph symbol, and appropriate signage pursuant to Section 5. below.
 - b. Where EVSE is installed, adequate site lighting and landscaping shall be provided in accordance with the Borough's ordinances and regulations.
 - c. Adequate EVSE protection such as concrete-filled steel bollards shall be used for publicly-accessible EVSE. Non-mountable curbing may be used in lieu of bollards if the EVSE is setback a minimum of 24 inches from the face of the curb. Any standalone EVSE bollards should be 3 to 4-feet high with concrete footings placed to protect the EVSE from accidental impact and to prevent damage from equipment used for snow removal.
 - d. EVSE outlets and connector devices shall be no less than 36 inches and no higher than 48 inches from the ground or pavement surface where mounted, and shall contain a cord management system as described in e. below. Equipment mounted on pedestals, lighting posts, bollards, or other devices shall be designated and located as to not impede pedestrian travel, create trip hazards on sidewalks, or impede snow removal.
 - e. Each EVSE shall incorporate a cord management system or method to minimize the potential for cable entanglement, user injury, or connector damage. Cords shall be retractable or have a place to hang the connector and cord a safe and sufficient distance above the ground or pavement surface. Any cords connecting the charger to a vehicle shall be configured so that they do not cross a driveway, sidewalk, or passenger unloading area.
 - f. Where EVSE is provided within a pedestrian circulation area, such as a sidewalk or other accessible route to a building entrance, the EVSE shall be located so as not to

interfere with accessibility requirements of the Uniform Construction Code, N.J.A.C. 5:23, and other applicable accessibility standards.

g. Publicly-accessible EVSEs shall be maintained in all respects, including the functioning of the equipment. A 24-hour on-call contact shall be provided on the equipment for reporting problems with the equipment or access to it. To allow for maintenance and notification, the Borough shall require the owners/designee of publiclyaccessible EVSE to provide information on the EVSE's geographic location, date of installation, equipment type and model, and owner contact information.

5. Signs

- a. Publicly-accessible EVSE shall have posted regulatory signs, as identified in this section, allowing only charging electric vehicles to park in such spaces. For purposes of this section, "charging" means that an electric vehicle is parked at an EVSE and is connected to the EVSE. If time limits or vehicle removal provisions are to be enforced, regulatory signs including parking restrictions shall be installed immediately adjacent to, and visible from the EVSE. For private EVSE, installation of signs and sign text is at the discretion of the owner.
- b. All regulatory signs shall comply with visibility, legibility, size, shape, color, and reflectivity requirements contained within the Federal Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices as published by the Federal Highway Administration.
- c. Wayfinding or directional signs, if necessary, shall be permitting at appropriate decision points to effectively guide motorists to the EVSE parking space(s).
 Wayfinding or directional signage shall be placed in a manner that shall not interfere with any parking space, drive lane, or exit and shall comply with b. above.
- d. In addition to the signage described above, the following information shall be available on the EVSE or posted at or adjacent to all publicly-accessible EVSE parking spaces:
 - Hour of operations and/or time limits if time limits or tow-away provisions are to be enforced by the municipality or owner/designee;
 - 2) Usage fees and parking fees, if applicable; and
 - 3) Contact information (telephone number) for reporting when the equipment is not operating or other problems.

- 6. Usage Fees
 - a. For publicly-accessible municipal EVSE In addition to any parking fees, the fee to use parking spaces within the municipality identified as EVSE spaces shall be established by resolution adopted by the governing body.
 - b. Private EVSE: Nothing in this ordinance shall be deemed to preclude a private owner/designee of an EVSE from collecting a fee for the use of the EVSE, in accordance with applicable State and Federal regulations. Fees shall be available on the EVSE or posted at or adjacent to the EVSE parking space.

Section 3. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 4. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

CONCERNING LAND DEVELOPMENTAPPLICATION PROCEDURES AND AMENDING ARTICLE 2 OF THE BOROUGH LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE ENTITLED "PLANNING BOARD" AND ARTICLE 3 ENTITLED "ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT"

Statement of Purpose: To require electronic copies of Planning Board and Board of Adjustment applications and to increase the number of copies of paper applications that must be filed with the Planning Board.

WHEREAS, both the Planning Board and the Board of Adjustment have requested that

the Borough Land Use Regulations be amended to require that electronic copies of application

materials be submitted in addition to the paper copies ; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board has also asked that the regulations be amended to

increase the number of paper copies of application materials that have to be submitted from 15 to

19;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of

Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that Articles 2 and 3 of the

Borough Land Development Regulations are hereby supplemented and amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 2-9 entitled "Applications; Procedures for Filing" is supplemented

and amended by amending sections 2-9.2 and 2-9.3 and by adding a new section 2-9.5 to read as follows:

§ 2-9 APPLICATIONS; PROCEDURES FOR FILING.

§ 2-9.1

Applications for development, including all required documents to insure completeness, within the jurisdiction of the Planning Board pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:55D-37 et seq. shall be obtained from and filed with the Administrative Officer, who shall also inform the applicant of the steps to be taken to initiate applications and of the regular meeting dates of the Board.

§ 2-9.2

For <u>all</u> development applications, <u>19</u> copies of <u>a complete application, including all forms, checklists, reports, drawings, etc. that are required for the application to be deemed complete, shall be filed with the Board's Administrative Officer. Initially, <u>10 sets of complete applications may be filed with the remaining 9 sets submitted not less than 10 days prior to the hearing date scheduled for the application.</u></u>

In addition to submittal of hard copies of documents, copies of all applications, surveys, plans, reports and studies, such as environmental impact, traffic, stormwater, sewer and water reports, and any other documents associated with the application, shall be submitted digitally, in portable document format (PDF) at 400 × 400 dpi. Submittal of such digital copies shall be required to constitute an application for development, and all revised files shall be resubmitted as the originals are changed or amended. Every electronic submission must be accompanied by a cover letter listing all attached documents and any revisions, where applicable.

§ 2-9.3

Any maps and documents subsequently required by the Planning Board shall also be filed in hard copy and digital (pdf) form and shall be on file in the office of the Administrative Officer and available for public inspection at least 10 days before the date of the hearing or consideration pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:55D-10b.

Section 2. Subsection 3-10.2 entitled "Applications; Review Checklist" in Section 3-

10 entitled "Appeals and Applications; Procedure for Filing,"" is hereby supplemented and

amended by adding a new paragraph "c" which reads as follows

§ 3-10.2 Applications; Review Checklist.

a. Applications addressed to the original jurisdiction of the Zoning Board of Adjustment shall be filed with the Board's Administrative Officer. The applicant shall file, at least 10 days before the date set for hearing, 21 copies of a complete application on the form(s) adopted by the Board, 21 copies of the applicable, completed review checklist, as adopted in Subsection **b** of this subsection, together with 21 copies of all reports, drawings, etc. that are required for the application to be deemed complete. Initially, 10 sets of applications (as per above) may be filed with the remaining 11 sets submitted not less than 10 days prior to the hearing date scheduled for the application. At the time of filing the appeal of application, but in no event less than 10 days prior to the date set for hearing, the applicant shall also file all plat plans, maps, or other papers required by virtue of any provision of this chapter or any rule of the Board of Adjustment. The applicant shall obtain all necessary forms from the Board Administrative Officer. The Administrative Officer shall inform the applicant of the steps to be taken to initiate proceedings and of the regular meeting dates of the Board. b. In addition to submittal of hard copies of documents, copies of all applications, surveys, plans, reports and studies, such as environmental impact, traffic, stormwater, sewer and water reports, and any other documents associated with the application, shall be submitted digitally in portable document format (pdf) at 400×400 dpi. Submittal of such digital copies shall be required to constitute an application for development, and all revised files shall be resubmitted as the originals are changed or amended. Every electronic submission must be accompanied by a cover letter listing all attached documents and any revisions, where applicable.

c. <u>Any maps and documents subsequently required by the Board of Adjustment shall</u> also be filed in hard copy and digital (pdf) form and shall be on file in the office of the Administrative Officer and available for public inspection at least 10 days before the date of the hearing or consideration pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:55D-10b.

d. Board of Adjustment Review Checklists which are incorporated herein by reference and which shall be included in Appendices A and B to this chapter are hereby adopted and shall be completed by all applicants in accordance with Subsection **a** above.

Section 3. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 4. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
