AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A LEASE EXTENSION WITH NEW JERSEY TRANSIT FOR THE LEASING OF THE BERNARDSVILLE RAILROAD STATION FOR A TERM OF FIVE YEARS WITH TWO ADDITIONAL TWO-YEAR OPTIONS

WHEREAS, New Jersey Transit Corporation ("NJ Transit") is the owner of the Bernardsville Railroad Station parcel, which is located on Mine Brook Road, and known as Block 144, Lot 1 on the Borough tax maps; and

WHEREAS, NJ Transit and the Borough of Bernardsville (the "Borough") entered into a Lease Agreement (hereinafter, "Lease") on November 7, 2006, for the lease to The Borough of portions of a station parcel situated on Block 144, Lot 1 on the Official Tax Map of the Borough of Bernardsville, also known as the Bernardsville Railroad Station. A copy of said Lease is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, NJ Transit and The Borough entered into a Lease Amendment Agreement on May 13, 2015, which, inter alia, extended the Term of the Lease to December 31, 2025; and WHEREAS, the Amended Term of the Lease will expire on December 31, 2025 (hereinafter, "Expiration Date"); and

WHEREAS, NJ Transit desires to continue to rent this station parcel beyond the Expiration Date; and

WHEREAS, NJ Transit and The Borough have agreed to extend the Lease (the "Second Lease Amendment") to provide for a five (5) year extension of the Expiration Date, for a revised expiration date of December 31, 2030, with two (2) additional option terms of two (2) years each (through December 31, 2034) (the "Option Terms").

WHEREAS, the lease gives the Borough the right to sublet the premises with the consent of NJ Transit, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld; and

WHEREAS, the lease requires the Borough, in the case of a sublease, to comply with the provisions of N.J.S.A 40A:12-24 which provides that:

"Every . . . municipality may lease for fixed and upon prescribed terms and for private purposes any land or building or any part thereof not presently needed for public use to the person who will pay the highest rent therefor. The use by the Borough shall be of such character as not to be detrimental to the building or the use of the building or the use of the building.;" and

WHEREAS, the Bernardsville Railroad Station is on the National Register of Historic Places and is an important part of downtown Bernardsville; and

WHEREAS, leasing the railroad station from NJ Transit will allow the Borough to regulate the use of the building and to monitor its upkeep and maintenance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and to the execute Second Lease
 Amendment with NJ Transit as described in the preamble.
- 2. This resolution supersedes and replaces Resolution 22-177, adopted September 12, 2022.
- 3. The Borough Attorney is authorized to negotiate the terms of a proposed sublease with Pizzeria Tatôn By MV in accordance with its October 6, 2021, proposal.

BOROUGH OF BERNARDSVILLE RESOLUTION #22-259

AUTHORIZING SUBLEASE OF THE BERNARDSVILLE RAILROAD STATION

WHEREAS, contemporaneously herewith the governing body is authorizing a lease extension with New Jersey Transit Corporation ("NJ Transit") for the Bernardsville Train Station to provide for a five (5) year extension of the Expiration Date, for a revised expiration date of December 31, 2030, with two (2) additional terms of two (2) years each (through December 31, 2034) (the "Option Terms"), subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Borough received two proposals in response to its RFP; and

WHEREAS, after considering those proposals, the governing body determined that the proposal submitted by Pizzeria Tatôn By MV to operate a pizza restaurant utilizing an authentic volcanic clay oven to create Neapolitan pizzas is most advantageous to the Borough and its residents inasmuch as it will be an attractive restaurant business occupying the historic Bernardsville Train Station and as such will contribute to the redevelopment of the downtown; and

WHEREAS, Pizzeria Tatôn By MV has asked for a rent concession of seven months of lease payments to cover the large scale renovations that will be needed; and

WHEREAS, Pizzeria Tatôn By MV has also asked the Borough to apply to the Director of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control for a special concessionaire permit pursuant to the provisions of N.J.A.C. 132-5.2, which will allow it to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption in the Railroad Station building; and

WHEREAS, this approval of the sublease agreement with Pizzeria Tatôn By MV is

subject to the approval of NJ Transit in accordance with the terms of the underlying lease

agreement between the Borough and NJ Transit; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Borough of

Bernardsville, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute a

sublease agreement with Pizzeria Tatôn By MV in a form acceptable to the Borough

Attorney.

2. The term of the sublease shall be concurrent with that of the underlying lease between

the Borough and NJ Transit, that is for a term of five years with two two-year renewal

options.

3. The sublease agreement may include a seven-month rent concession as requested by

Pizzeria Tatôn By MV.

4. The rents during years one and two of the sublease agreement shall be \$1,500 a month

commencing in the eighth month and ending in the twenty-fourth month.

5.In accordance with Pizzeria Tatôn By MV 's proposal, the monthly rents for years three

through nine shall be as follows:

Years three and four: \$2,000

Year five: \$3,000 Year six: \$3,500

Year six: \$3,500

Year seven: \$4,000

Years eight and nine: \$4,500

6.Pizzeria Tatôn By MV shall post a security deposit of \$3,000 (two months' rent) upon

execution of the sublease agreement. The amount of the security deposit will be increased

whenever the rent is increased so that the Borough is always holding two months' rent security deposit during the term of the sublease.

7.Pizzeria Tatôn By MV shall renovate the train station building in accordance with its proposal at the approximate cost of \$650,000.

8. The Borough will work with Pizzeria Tatôn By MV to obtain a concessionaire [alcoholic beverage] permit for the site.

9. The effectiveness of this resolution is contingent upon the Borough's receiving NJ Transit's approval of the proposed sublease as required by the underlying lease.
