Proclaiming the month of September 2023 as Prostate Cancer Awareness Month

WHEREAS, This year, approximately 288,300 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in the United States alone – one man every 2 minutes, and roughly 34,700 will die this year from the disease, about 3,500 more than 2020 – which is one man every 15 minutes; and

WHEREAS, In New Jersey, an estimated 9,460 new cases of prostate cancer will be diagnosed and an estimated 730 deaths will occur in 2023; and

WHEREAS, Men with relatives – father, brother, son – with a history of prostate cancer are twice as likely to develop the disease; and

WHEREAS, Prostate cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer in American Men and the third leading cause of cancer death behind lung and colon cancer; and

WHEREAS, 1 in 8 men are diagnosed with prostate cancer in their lifetime and 1 in 6 African American men will develop prostate cancer in their lifetime. Overall, African American men are 1.7 times more likely to be diagnosed with - and 2.1 times more likely to die from - prostate cancer than white men; and

WHEREAS, Veterans who were exposed to herbicides like Agent Orange are at increased risk for developing prostate cancer, and are more likely to have an aggressive form of the disease; and

WHEREAS, Education regarding prostate cancer and early detection strategies is critical to saving lives, preserving, and protecting our families. As well as the economic and social burden of prostate cancer is huge on families; and

WHEREAS, If caught early prostate cancer has a five-year survival rate of nearly 100%. However, for late stage prostate cancer the five-year survival rate is 31%; and

WHEREAS, Many more men will be diagnosed in 2023 at a later stage because of delayed screenings and treatment due to Covid-19; and

WHEREAS, All men are at risk for prostate	e cancer and	we encourage the	residents of the
Borough of Bernardsville to increase the imp	portance of	prostate awareness	and screenings.

RESOLUTION #2023-14 OF THE PLANNING BOARD OF THE BOROUGH OF BERNARDSVILLE FINDING THAT ORDINANCE NO. 2023-1974, ALLOWING NON-FAMILY MEMBERS TO OCCUPY DETACHED ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS IN THE R-1 AND R-1-10 ZONES, IS NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE BOROUGH'S MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2023, at a duly noticed and constituted public meeting, the Borough Council of the Borough of Bernardsville (the "Borough Council") introduced, on first reading, proposed Ordinance No. 2023-1974 (the "Proposed Ordinance"), which would allow non-family members to occupy detached accessory dwelling units in the R-1 and R-1-10 zones; and

WHEREAS, after introduction, the Borough Council referred the Proposed Ordinance to the Planning Board of the Borough of Bernardsville (the "Board") for Master Plan consistency review, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-26(a) and N.J.S.A. 40:55D-64; and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2023, at a duly noticed and constituted public meeting, the Board considered the testimony of the Board Planner and any comments from members of the public and determined that the Proposed Ordinance is not inconsistent with the Borough's Master Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board as follows:

- Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in full;
- Section 2. The Board hereby finds and determines that Ordinance No. 2023-1974, which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, is not inconsistent with the Borough's Master Plan and recommends that the Borough Council consider, from a policy perspective, whether it desires to continue treating detached accessory dwelling units as conditional uses, which requires Planning Board application even for fully conforming conditional uses, or alternatively to designate same as permitted accessory uses, which would only require a land use board application in the event of some other relief being necessitated by the development project;
- Section 3. The Recording Secretary of the Board shall forward a copy of this Resolution with the attached Ordinance to the Borough Council. This Resolution shall serve as the report to the governing body in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:55D-26(a) and N.J.S.A. 40:55D-64; and
 - Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE #2023-1974

ALLOWING NON-FAMILY MEMBERS TO OCCUPY DETACHED ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS IN THE R-1 AND R-1-10 ZONES

WHEREAS, detached accessory dwelling units are permitted as conditional uses in the R-1 and R-1-10 zones pursuant to § LD12-25; and

WHEREAS, paragraph "m" of § LD12-25.2 limits the occupancy of detached accessory dwelling units to on-site domestic employees, members of the immediate family or non-paying short-term guests of the residents of the principal residence; and

WHEREAS, the Housing/Property Maintenance/Zoning Compliance Advisory

Committee has recommended that those restrictions be removed; and

WHEREAS, the governing body agrees with the recommendation of the Housing/Property Maintenance/Zoning Compliance Advisory Committee;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that subparagraphs 3, 8 and 9 in paragraph "m" of § LD-12-25.2 entitled "Conditional Uses Permitted" is amended as follows:

"m. Accessory Dwelling Unit, Detached,.... The following conditions shall be met:

3. The detached accessory dwelling unit shall be for the sole use of the on-site domestic employees, members of the immediate family or non-paying short-term guest of the resident of the principal residence except, when the owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program. In any event, the The detached accessory dwelling unit shall not be occupied by more than four persons.

8. The applicant shall submit at the time of seeking conditional use approval, and annually thereafter, a certification on forms provided by the Borough, as follows:

- (a) That the detached accessory dwelling unit is occupied by on-site domestic employees of the residents of the principal residence or by members of the immediate family or short term, nonpaying guest of the residents of the principal residence, except when the Owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program. In any event, the detached accessory dwelling unit shall be occupied by no more than four persons.
- (b) That the detached accessory dwelling unit is not a rental unit and no rent is paid on account of the occupancy of the accessory apartment, except when the Owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program.
- (c) That the living area of the detached dwelling unit is not a rental unit and no rent is paid on account of the occupancy of the accessory apartment, except when the Owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program.
- (d) That upon any violation of this section or the certification, determined by the appropriate Borough official, the violation shall be abated and the owner shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Article 16 of this Code.
- 9. Prior to issuance of a building permit for the detached accessory dwelling unit, a new deed shall be recorded in the Somerset County Clerk's Office containing a restriction stating that the detached accessory dwelling unit must be used in strict compliance with this section.
- **Section 2.** Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.
- **Section 3.** In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.
- **Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

PROHIBITING DRIVE-THROUGHS IN THE DOWNTOWN ZONE DISTRICT AND SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING ARTICLE 12 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "ZONING"

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to prohibit drive-through facilities in all downtown zone districts

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that § LD-12-12 entitled "Downtown District" in the Borough Land Development Regulations is hereby supplemented and amended as follows:

Section 1. § LD-12-12.6 entitled, "Permitted Uses in the Downtown District and All Subdistricts" is amended by deleting paragraph "n" as follows:

§ LD-12-12.6 Permitted Uses in the Downtown District and All Subdistricts.

Unless specifically prohibited within a subdistrict or elsewhere in this section, the following uses are permitted in the Downtown District:

n. Drive-through facilities shall be allowed for pharmacies only.

Section 2. § LD-12-12.10 entitled, "Specifically Prohibited Uses" is supplemented and amended by adding a new paragraph "t" which reads as follows:

§ LD-12-12.10 Prohibited Uses.

In addition to the uses prohibited in § 12-23.16, any use not specifically enumerated as expressly permitted herein is hereby prohibited including the following specific uses in all subdistricts unless otherwise indicated:

t. Drive-through facilities.

Section 3. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 4. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

PROHIBITING SMOKING IN OUTDOOR DINING AREAS IN THE DOWNTOWN DISTRICT AND AMENDING ARTICLE 12 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "ZONING"

WHEREAS, section LD-12-12.9 of the Borough Land Development Regulations which regulates outdoor dining does not currently prohibit smoking; and

WHEREAS, the governing body believes that smoking in outdoor dining areas affects the health, comfort and convenience of staff members and other patrons of the restaurant and should be prohibited;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Land Development Regulations are hereby supplemented and amended as follows:

Section 2. Paragraph "b" of section LD-12-12.9 entitled "Outdoor Dining" is hereby supplemented and amended by adding a new paragraph "g", which reads as follows:

Outdoor Dining shall be permitted within the Downtown District as accessory to an existing indoor restaurant only subject to the following regulations:

g. Smoking and the use of smokeless tobacco products is prohibited in all outdoor dining areas. For purposes of this section, "smoking" shall mean the inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying of a lighted or heated cigar, cigarette, pipe, electronic smoking device, or any other tobacco or plant product intended for human consumption through inhalation, in any manner or in any form.

Section 2. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 3. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 2023-1980

PROHIBITING SMOKELESS TOBACCO USE IN BOROUGH BUILDINGS, PARKS, PLAYGROUNDS, RECREATION AREAS AND VEHICLES ADDING DEFINITIONS OF "SMOKING" (TO INCLUDE "VAPING") AND "SMOKELESS TOBACCO" TO SECTION 3-8 OF THE BOROUGH CODE WHICH PROHIBITS SMOKING

WHEREAS. section 3-8 of the Borough Code prohibits smoking in borough buildings, parks, playgrounds, recreation areas and vehicles, but does not explicitly prohibit vaping or the use of smokeless tobacco; and

WHEREAS, the governing body wants to clarify the ordinance so that vaping and the use of smokeless tobacco are explicitly prohibited;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that in Section 3-8 entitled "Smoking Prohibited in Municipal Buildings, Parks, Playgrounds, Recreation Areas and Vehicles" in Article 3 of the Borough Code entitled "Police Regulations" is supplemented and amended as follows:

Section 1. § 3-8.1 of the Borough Code entitled, "Smoking Prohibited in Borough Facilities and Vehicles" is supplemented and amended to read as follows:

"In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:33-13, smoking <u>and the use of smokeless tobacco are</u> hereby prohibited in all Borough buildings, parks, playgrounds and recreation areas and within 25 feet of any entrance to a Borough building, and in all Borough vehicles."

Section 2. Subsection 3-8.2 entitled "Definitions" is supplemented and amended by adding the following definition of "smoking" in alphabetical order:

3-8.2 Definitions.

As used in this section:

SMOKING

Shall mean the inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying of a lighted or heated cigar, cigarette, pipe, electronic smoking device, or any other tobacco or plant product intended for human consumption through inhalation, in any manner or in any form.

SMOKELESS TOBACCO

Shall mean a fine-grained tobacco that often comes in teabag-like pouches that users put between their lower lip or cheek and gum. Chewing tobacco (also known as snuff or chew) comes in shredded, twisted, or bricked tobacco leaves.

Section 3. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 4. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

6. Accessory Dwelling Unit, Detached.

§ LD-12-6 R-1A RESIDENCE DISTRICT. § LD-12-6.1 Primary Intended Use.

This zone district is designed for single family residential use but permits any use as permitted and regulated in R-1 Residence District, except for detached accessory dwelling units, including conditional uses pursuant to § 12-25 limited to the following:

§ LD-12-6.2 Prohibited Uses.

Any use other than those permitted in Subsection 12-5.1 12-6.1 is prohibited.

§ LD-12-22 **R-1-10 RESIDENCE DISTRICT.** § LD-12-22.1 **Primary Intended Uses.**

This zone district is designed for single family residential use but permits:

- f. Accessory Dwelling Units, Detached.
- f.g. Other accessory uses customarily incident to the above uses provided they do not include any activity commonly conducted for gain unless specifically permitted in this Article.
- <u>g.h.</u> Conditional Uses pursuant to § 12-25, limited to the following:

6. Accessory Dwelling Unit, Detached.
